 - Posters will be available only for in-person viewing at the meeting; however, virtual attendees can observe the live-streamed *Poster Blitz* on Friday, October 7th, and will have access to the virtual Abstract Book.

Poster Information

- Can I present my poster virtually?
 - No, posters must be presented at the in-person meeting in Rochester. All poster presenters are required to register for the Fall Meeting. Poster presenters should be at their posters during scheduled breaks for interaction with attendees. Additionally, poster presenters are required to present a brief summary of their poster during the *Poster Blitz* on Friday, October 7, 2022, at 5:30 PM 7:30 PM EDT.
- Where do I find my poster number?
 - Poster number assignments will be emailed to all poster presenters prior to the Fall Meeting. Please check your email for correspondence regarding your specific poster number.
- What if someone else is in my space?
 - If there is a poster incorrectly mounted on your board, please ask the SPP staff for assistance. Please do not remove the poster without staff assistance.
